




Q1 What CSP membership group do you belong to?






Q3 Which best describes your employer for your main or usual job?


Q4 Please tell us which NHS pay band applies to your main role




Q6 In which region do you study or perform your usual work?







Q9 What is your sexual orientation?





Q10 What is your gender identity?





Q11 Is your gender identity the same as assigned to you at birth?









Q14 Are you currently pregnant?





Q15 Have you had a baby in the last 12 months?




















Q27 Have you experienced harassment, victimisation, or discrimination while working?


Q28 Which form of harassment, victimisation, or discrimination did you face/witness?










